3. The Meme World Today

It's a mass grave of broken promises —

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What we got instead:

- Copy-paste tokens with zero utility
- Anonymous teams with Telegram bios and no plans
- Presales that fund Ferraris, not products
- Discords built for ten minutes of pump before going radio silent

It's just a meme coin. What did you expect?

We expected **more**.

More than fake hype cycles.

4. The Vandal Solution

And the doors it opens weren't meant to be unlocked.

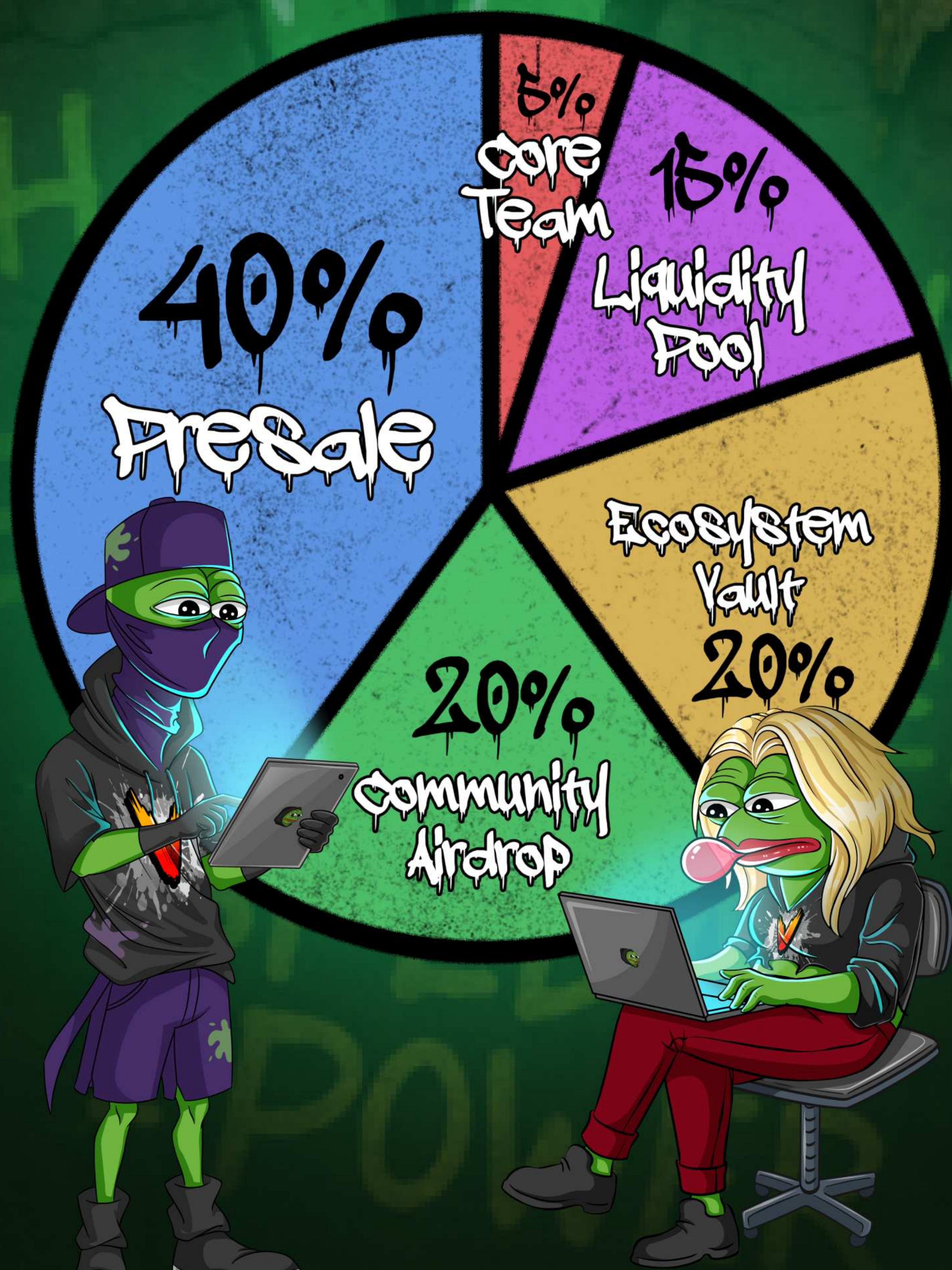
7. Tokenomics

8. Presale

No private rounds.

You ape fast? You get rewarded.

9. Loot & NFTs

Vault keys

These aren't JPEGs.

10. NFT CATEGORIES



Loot NFTs

Pure randomness — some junk, some legendary.
Redeemable, burnable, tradeable.



Vault Keys

Give access to RWA-backed content (art, gold, music, land). Rare and guarded.



Gear

Boosts your raid power or staking yield. Think of it like leveling up



Vandal ID Tags

Tied to rank, reputation, and privileges inside the Vandal Army.



Vault Keys

Single-use items that trigger major game events: raid bombs, vote overrides, burns

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This isn't about floor price.

This is about **functionality**.

Each NFT is either a **tool**, a **key**, or a **trigger**.

Some get burned.

Some get traded.

Some get stolen.

But all of them make noise.

We don't collect.

We equip.

We deploy.

We Vandalize.



11. Roadmap

This isn't a roadmap.

This is a plan for organized destruction — executed in Acts, not quarters.
